At all times herein mentioned, Respondent was 1 licensed by the Department of Real Estate of the State of 2 California as a real estate salesperson employed by licensed real 3 estate broker Beachside Realtors dba Century 21 Beachside 5 Realtors. In or about September and October, 2008, for or in 6 expectation of compensation, Respondent solicited and negotiated 7 a re-finance loan and loan modification on real property located 8 at 10129 Willowbrook Road, Riverside, California, for borrowers 9 Cesar H. Ortega and Rosa E. Ortega. Respondent accepted \$3,000 10 in advance from borrowers for loan modification services. 11 In or about November, 2008, for or in expectation 12 5. of compensation, Respondent solicited and negotiated a re-finance 13 loan and loan modification on real property located at 233 Galiceno Drive, San Jacinto, California, for borrowers Irene Ortega and Humberto Ortega, Jr. Respondent accepted \$1,500 in advance from borrowers for loan modification services. 17 Respondent's employing broker was not aware of the 18 .6. above transactions. 19 Respondent violated Code Section 10145(c) by 20 collecting advance fees from the borrowers Cesar H. Ortega and 21 Rosa E. Ortega and Irene Ortega and Humberto Ortega, Jr. and 22 failed to forward the funds about \$1,500 and \$3,000 (total 23 \$4,500) to her employing broker. 24 8. Respondent's activities are acts requiring a real 25 estate broker license under the provisions of Code Section 10131(d) and (e).

Respondent misappropriated the funds she received from the borrowers Cesar H. Ortega and Rosa E. Ortega and Irene Ortega and Humberto Ortega, Jr. without the knowledge or permission of the borrowers.

The conduct of Respondent, as alleged above, subjects her real estate license and license rights to suspension or revocation pursuant to Sections 10177(f) and 10177(j) of the Code, and Sections 10177(d) and/or 10177(g) for violation of Code Sections 10130 and 10145(c).

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action against all licenses and license rights of Respondent MARIA ELENA GARCIA under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code) and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other applicable provisions of law.
