ORDER SUSPENDING REAL ESTATE LICENSE

On June 5, 2013, a restricted real estate salesperson license was issued to Respondent IRFAN NAZIR License ID 01237704, on the terms, conditions and restrictions set forth in the Bureau of Real Estate ("Bureau") Commissioner's Decision in Case No. H-37934 LA. This Order which became effective on

June 5, 2013, provided that the right to a restricted real estate salesperson license was subject to the provisions of Section 10156.7 of the Business and Professions Code and to enumerated additional terms, conditions and restrictions imposed under authority of Section 10156.6 of said Code ("Code").

Among the terms and conditions of the Order,
Respondent was required to: (1) take and pass the Professional
Responsibility Examination within six (6) months from the
effective date of the Decision; and (2) provide satisfactory
proof of completion of 45 hours of approved continuing education
courses within nine (9) months from the effective date of the
Decision. The Commissioner has determined that Respondent has
failed to satisfy one or more of these conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED under authority of the Order issued in this matter that the real estate officer license heretofore issued to Respondent and the exercise of any privileges thereunder is hereby suspended until such time as Respondent provides proof satisfactory to the Bureau of compliance with the "conditions" referred to above, or pending final determination made after hearing (see "Hearing Rights" set forth below).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all license certificates and identification cards issued by Bureau which are in the possession of Respondent be immediately surrendered by personal delivery or by mailing in the enclosed, self-addressed envelope to:

Unless a written request for a hearing, signed by or on behalf of you, is delivered or mailed to the Bureau of Real Estate at 320 W. 4th Street, Room 350, Los Angeles, California 90013, within 20 days after the date that this Order was mailed to or served on you, the Bureau will not be obligated or required to provide you with a hearing.

This Order shall be effective immediately.
