On or about August 4, 2011, Respondent made application to the Department of Real Estate of the State of California for a real estate salesperson license.

(CRIMINAL CONVICTIONS)

2.

On or about April 9, 1997, in the Municipal Court of Huntington Park Courthouse Judicial District, County of Los Angeles, California, Case No. 7SE00949, Respondent was convicted of violating California Penal Code Section 417.4 (brandishing an imitation firearm), a misdemeanor. Said crime bears a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

On or about September 22, 1997, in the Superior Court of Southeast District Judicial District, County of Los Angeles, California, Case No. VA043774, Respondent was convicted of violating California Penal Code Section 12020(a) (possession of a dangerous weapon), a felony. Said crime bears a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

4.

On or about July 27, 1998, in the Municipal Court of Metropolitan Courthouse Judicial District, County of Los Angeles, California, Case No. 8MT08416, Respondent was convicted of violating California Vehicle Code Section 12500(a) (driving without a license), a misdemeanor. Said crime bears a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions or

duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

On or about January 12, 2000, in the Municipal Court of Huntington Park, County of Los Angeles, California, Case No. 9SE05053, Respondent was convicted of violating California Vehicle Code Section 14601.1(a) (driving with a suspended license), a misdemeanor. Said crime bears a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

6.

On or about June 16, 2008, in the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles, Case No. 16946AS, Respondent was convicted of violating California Vehicle Code Section 12500(a) (driving without a valid license) and 40508A (violating written promise to appear), both misdemeanors. Said crimes bear a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

On or about December 4, 2009, in the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles, Case No. 8DY04544, Respondent was convicted of violating California Vehicle Code Section 14601.1(a) (driving with a suspended license), a misdemeanor. Said crime bears a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee

under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

The crimes of which Respondent was convicted as alleged in Paragraphs 2 through 7 constitute cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license under California Business and Professions Code Sections 475(a)(2), 480(a), and 10177(b).

(FAILURE TO REVEAL CONVICTIONS)

In response to Question 23 of his license application, to wit: "HAVE YOU EVER BEEN CONVICTED OF A MISDEMEANOR OR FELONY? CONVICTIONS EXPUNGED UNDER PENAL CODE SECTION 1203.4 MUST BE DISCLOSED. HOWEVER, YOU MAY OMIT TRAFFIC CITATIONS WHICH DO NOT CONSTITUTE A MISDEMEANOR OR FELONY," Respondent answered "Yes," but failed to reveal the convictions described in Paragraphs 4 and 7, above.

10.

Respondent's failure to reveal the convictions in his license application constitutes knowingly making a false statement of material fact required to be revealed in said application, which is grounds for denial of the issuance of a license under California Business and Professions Code Sections 475(a)(1), 480(c), and 10177(a).

These proceedings are brought under the provisions of Section 10100, Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code

of the State of California and Sections 11500 through 11528 of the California Government Code.

wherefore, the Complainant prays that the aboveentitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the
charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to
authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of, a real
estate salesperson license to Respondent, MANUEL R. AVILA ARCEO,
and for such other and further relief as may be proper under
other applicable provisions of law.
