(CRIMINAL CONVICTIONS)

3.

On or about February 8, 2011, in the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles, in case no. 9LT05402, Respondent was convicted of violating of California Vehicle Code Section 23152(b) (driving with a blood alcohol level of 0.08 percent or greater) and California Penal Code Section 148(a)(1) (obstructing a public officer), both misdemeanors. These crimes are substantially related to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

4.

On or about September 12, 2011, in the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles, in case no. BA383517, Respondent was convicted of violating of California Vehicle Code Section 23152(b) (driving with a blood alcohol level of 0.08 percent or greater), a felony. This crime is substantially related to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

5.

In aggravation, on or about September 13, 2002, in the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles, in case no. 2CH00453, Respondent was convicted of violating of California Vehicle Code Section 23103 (reckless driving), a misdemeanor.

In aggravation, on or about February 28, 2007, in the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles, in case no. 7GN00554, Respondent was convicted of violating of California Vehicle Code Section 23152(b) (driving with a blood alcohol level of 0.08 percent or greater), a misdemeanor.

7.

The crimes of which Respondent was convicted, as described above, constitute cause under California Business and Professions Code Sections 490 and 10177(b) for the suspension or revocation of the license and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law.

California Business and Professions Code Section 10106 provides, in pertinent part, that in any order issued in resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the department, the Commissioner may request the administrative law judge to direct a licensee found to have committed a violation of this part to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of investigation and enforcement of the case.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action against all licenses and/or license rights under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the California Business and Professions Code) of Respondent ALVINA DELOURDES HIZNAY for the cost of investigation and enforcement as permitted by law, and

for such other and further relief as may be proper under applicable provisions of law.
