During the term of the restricted license, 10 Respondent shall submit proof to Manager of the Crisis Response Team in the Los Angeles District Office, that 11 he is making payments as agreed, to each Federal and 12 State entity that holds a tax lien against him. Such proof shall be submitted twice a year, at the end of 13 each June and December.
