The Complainant, Robin Trujillo, a Deputy Real Estat

19 The Complainant makes this Statement of Issues again
20 Respondent in her official capacity as a Deputy Real Estate
21 Commissioner of the State of California.

23 On or about October 12, 2010, Respondent made
24 application to the Department of Real Estate of the State of
25 California for a real estate salesperson license.
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2 On or about February 9, 2006, in the Superior Court of 3 California, County of Los Angeles, Case No. 6LG00178, Respondent 4 pled *nolo contendere* and was convicted of violating California 5 Penal Code Section 485 (theft), a misdemeanor. Respondent was 6 sentenced to three years summary probation, ordered to serve 15 7 days in county jail, and ordered to pay fines.

On or about August 22, 2005, in the Superior Court of 9 California, County of Los Angeles, Case No.5LC04204, Respondent 10 pled nolo contendere and was convicted of violating California 11 Penal Code Section 487(a)(grand theft), a misdemeanor. 12 Respondent was sentenced to 36 months summary probation, ordered 13 to serve 30 days in county jail, and ordered to pay fines. In 14 addition, Respondent was ordered to stay at least 100 yards from 15 the victim's person, residence, place of business, and/ or 16 school. 17

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On or about July 22, 2005, in the Superior Court of 19 California, County of Los Angeles, Case No.5LM04834, Respondent 20 21 pled nolo contendere and was convicted of violating California Penal Code Section 484(a) (petty theft), a misdemeanor. 22 Respondent was sentenced to one year summary probation and 23 ordered to pay fines (or perform 40 hours of community service 24 or serve five days in county jail). Additionally, Respondent was 25 ordered to stay at least 100 yards away from the Walmart located 26 at 151 E. 5th St. 27

6. 1 On or about September 17, 2003, in the Superior Court 2 of California, County of Los Angeles, Case No.3LL02195, 3 Respondent pled nolo contendere and was convicted of violating 4 California Vehicle Code Section 12500(a) (driving w/out a 5 license), a misdemeanor. Respondent was sentenced to one year 6 summary probation and ordered to pay fines (or perform five days 7 community service). 8 7. 9 These crimes, by their facts and circumstances, bear a 10substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 11 6, California Code of Regulations, to the qualifications, 12 functions or duties of a real estate licensee. 13 8. 14 The crimes of which Respondent was convicted 15constitute cause for denial of Respondent's application for a 16 real estate license under Business and Professions Code Sections 17 475(a)(2), 480(a), and 10177(b). 18 These proceedings are brought under the provisions of 19 Section 10100, Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code 20 21 of the State of California and Sections 11500 through 11528 of the California Government Code. 22 111 23 111 24 111 25 26 111 111 27 - 3 -
