AMENDED STATEMENT OF ISSUES

The Complainant, Robin Trujillo, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, acting in her official capacity, for Statement of Issues against ONE WAY LENDING, INC. and JULIO ENRIQUE GONZALEZ JR. ("Respondents") alleges as follows:

1.

At all times herein mentioned, Respondent JULIO ENRIOUE GONZALEZ JR. ("GONZALEZ") was licensed under the Real Estate Law, Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code ("Code") as a real estate broker. Respondent GONZALEZ was first licensed as a real estate broker on November 16, 2004. During the period November 17, 2004, to November 5, 2012,

GONZALEZ was the Designated Officer of licensed corporate real estate broker California Finance Group Inc. (CFGI").

2.

On November 28, 2011, the Department of Real Estate filed its Accusation against Respondent GONZALEZ and CFGI in Case No. H-37695 LA alleging violations of the Real Estate Laws and Regulations. On August 13, 2012, Respondent GONZALEZ, as designated officer, petitioned the Real Estate Commissioner for the voluntarily surrender of the corporate real estate license of CFGI. Said surrender was accepted by the Real Estate Commissioner effective November 5, 2012. Effective November 15, 2012, in Case No. H-37695 LA, the Real Estate Commissioner imposed discipline on the license of Respondent GONZALEZ pursuant to Business and Professions Code Sections 10085, and 10177(d).

On or about February 8, 2012, Respondent GONZALEZ made application to the Department of Real Estate of the State of California ("Department") for a corporate real estate broker license, on behalf of Respondent ONE WAY LENDING, INC. ("OWLI").

In response to Question 20 of the corporation license application, to wit: "ARE THERE ANY LICENSE DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS PENDING AGAINST A BUSINESS OR PROFESIONAL LICENSE YOU HOLD AT THIS TIME?", Respondent GONZALEZ marked the box denoted "No" and failed to reveal the discipline against his real estate broker license and the license of the real estate corporate

broker for which GONZALEZ was licensed as the designated officer as described in Paragraph 2, above.

Respondent GONZALEZ's failure to disclose the prior disciplinary action regarding his real estate licenses, as set forth above in Paragraph 2, in the real estate corporation license application for Respondent OWLI, constitutes the attempt to procure a license by fraud, misrepresentation, or deceit, or by making a false statement of material fact required to be revealed in said application, which is grounds for denial of the issuance of a license under Business and Professions Code Sections 475(a)(1), 480(c) and 10177(a).

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WHEREFORE, the Complainant prays that the aboveentitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of, a corporate real estate broker license to Respondents ONE WAY LENDING, INC. and JULIO ENRIQUE GONZALEZ JR., and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other applicable provisions of law.
