15 The Complainant, Robin Trujillo, a Deputy Real Estate
16 Commissioner of the State of California, acting in her official
17 capacity, for Statement of Issues against CHRISTOPHER BRYANT
18 CAMARENA ("Respondent") alleges as follows:

19 1.

20 On or about October 11, 2011, Respondent made
21 application to the Department of Real Estate of the State of
22 California ("Department") for a real estate salesperson license.

23 (CRIMINAL CONVICTIONS)

24 2.

25 On or about January 13, 2004, in the Superior Court of
26 California, County of San Bernardino, Case No. FRE006504,
27 Respondent was convicted of violating Penal Code Sections 220

1 (Assault with Intent to Commit Sexual Penetration by Foreign
2 Object) and 243(d) (Battery with Great Bodily Injury Likely),
3 both felonies. Said crimes bear a substantial relationship to
4 the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate
5 licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California
6 Code of Regulations.

7 3.

8 On or about December 17, 2002, in the Superior Court
9 of California, County of San Bernardino, Case No. MCH013938,
10 Respondent was convicted of violating Penal Code Section 602(1)
11 (Trespass: Occupy Property without Consent), a misdemeanor.
12 Said crime bears a substantial relationship to the
13 qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee
14 under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of
15 Regulations.

16 4.

17 The crimes of which Respondent was convicted, as
18 alleged above, constitute cause for denial of Respondent's
19 application for a real estate license under Business and
20 Professions Code Sections 475(a)(2), 480(a), and 10177(b).

21
22 These proceedings are brought under the provisions of
23 Section 10100, Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code
24 of the State of California and Sections 11500 through 11528 of
25 the California Government Code.


