On or about October 11, 2011, Respondent made application to the Department of Real Estate of the State of California ("Department") for a real estate salesperson license. (CRIMINAL CONVICTIONS)

On or about January 13, 2004, in the Superior Court of California, County of San Bernardino, Case No. FRE006504, Respondent was convicted of violating Penal Code Sections 220

(Assault with Intent to Commit Sexual Penetration by Foreign Object) and 243(d)(Battery with Great Bodily Injury Likely), both felonies. Said crimes bear a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

3.

On or about December 17, 2002, in the Superior Court of California, County of San Bernardino, Case No. MCH013938, Respondent was convicted of violating Penal Code Section 602(1) (Trespass: Occupy Property without Consent), a misdemeanor. Said crime bears a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

4.

The crimes of which Respondent was convicted, as alleged above, constitute cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license under Business and Professions Code Sections 475(a)(2), 480(a), and 10177(b).

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These proceedings are brought under the provisions of Section 10100, Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California and Sections 11500 through 11528 of the California Government Code.

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WHEREFORE, the Complainant prays that the aboveentitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the
charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to
authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of, a real
estate salesperson license to Respondent, CHRISTOPHER BRYANT
CAMARENA, and for such other and further relief as may be proper
under other applicable provisions of law.
