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

On or about February 3, 2012, the State Bar Court in the Supreme Court of California, in Case No. 10-0-04424 (11-0-10374; 11-0-13230) ordered that Respondent, State Bar No. 210764, be suspended from the practice of law in California for two years (stayed) and that he be placed on probation for two years for violation of Rules of Professional Conduct Rule 4-100(A) (commingling); two counts for violation of Business and Professions Code Section 6106.3 (collecting advanced fees for loan modifications after October 11, 2009); and Rules of Professional Conduct Rule 3-110(A) (failure to perform with competence). In addition, Respondent was ordered to pay restitution in the amount \$12,230 plus interest.

The acts resulting in the foregoing action taken with respect to Respondent, as alleged herein above in Paragraph 3, constitute cause under Business and Professions Code Section 10177(f) for the suspension or revocation of the license and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law.
