

15 The Complainant, Maria Suarez, a Deputy Real Estate  
16 Commissioner of the State of California, acting in her official  
17 capacity, for cause of Accusation against VALERIE LEE BARBER  
18 ("Respondent") alleges as follows:

20 Respondent is presently licensed and/or has license  
21 rights under the Real Estate Law, Part 1 of Division 4 of the  
22 California Business and Professions Code ("Code"), as a real  
23 estate broker.

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(LICENSE DISCIPLINE)

2.

On or about May 19, 2011, the Supreme Court of California issued an Order in State Bar Court Case Nos. 09-O-12143, 09-O-13356, 09-O-13675, and 10-O-00933 that the license of Respondent to practice law, License No. 170148, be suspended for a period of one year, stayed, with 30 days actual suspension and probation for two years, and that Respondent satisfy further conditions, all based on Respondent's violation of the Business and Professions Code.

3.

The acts resulting in the foregoing action taken with respect to Respondent's license to practice law, as described above, constitute cause under Section 10177(f) of the Business & Professions Code for the suspension or revocation of the license and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law.

California Business and Professions Code Section 10106 provides, in pertinent part, that in any order issued in resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the department, the Commissioner may request the administrative law judge to direct a licensee found to have committed a violation of this part to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of investigation and enforcement of the case.

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
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WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action against all the licenses and license rights of Respondent, VALERIE LEE BARBER, under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code), for the costs of investigation and enforcement as provided by law, and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other applicable provisions of law.
