ACCUSATION

The Complainant, Robin Trujillo, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, for cause of accusation

The Complainant, Robin Trujillo, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, makes this Accusation in

EDDIE WAI HUNG WONG (hereinafter referred to as "Respondent") is presently licensed and/or has license rights under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code, hereinafter referred to as the "Code").

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Respondent was licensed by the Bureau of Real Estate of the State of California as a real estate salesperson effective May 20, 1994.

IV

On or about December 5, 2011, in the County of Los Angeles, Superior Court of California, Respondent was convicted of two counts of violating Penal Code Section 134 (preparing false documentary evidence), felonies.

The above referenced matter bears a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate licensee, Title 10, Chapter 6, Section 2910, California Administrative Code.

VI

Respondent's conviction alleged in Paragraph IV is cause under Code Sections 490 and 10177(b) for suspension or revocation of all licenses and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law.

VII

On or about April 16, 2012, the California Insurance Commissioner revoked the license and license rights of Respondent for violation of Insurance Code Section 1669(a) in conjunction with Section 1738 thereby subjecting Respondent's real estate license to disciplinary action under Code Section 10177(f). ///

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Business and Professions Code Section 10106 provides, in pertinent part, that in any order issued in resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the Bureau, the commissioner may request the administrative law judge to direct a licensee found to have committed a violation of this part to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of the case.

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action against all licenses and license rights of Respondent EDDIE WAI HUNG WONG, for the cost of investigation and enforcement as permitted by law, under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code) and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other applicable provisions of law.
