19 20	1. On or about November 19, 2012, Respondent made
20	application to the Bureau of Real Estate of the State of
22	California for a real estate broker license.

26	On or about May 22, 2012, the Supreme Court of
27	California, case no. S199672, suspended Respondent from the

1 practice of law for one year, execution of that suspension 2 stayed, and placed Respondent on probation for two years subject 3 to certain terms and conditions for accepting advanced fees for 4 loan modification matters.

3.

The grounds for discipline are set forth in the 6 7 Stipulation re Facts, Conclusions of Law, and Disposition and 8 Order Approving, case nos. 10-0-10090, 10-0-10216, 10-0-1103, 10-0-10538, 10-0-11824, 10-0-12055, 10-0-12936, 10-0-13588, 10-9 0-14017, and 10-0-14382, filed on or about December 9, 2011. 10 The State Bar Court concluded Respondent violated (1) California 11 Civil Code section 2944.7 by claiming, demanding, charging, 12 collecting, or receiving any compensation until after Respondent 13 had fully performed each and every service he contracted to 14 15 perform or represented that he would perform in residential mortgage loan modification matters he had been hired to perform 16 and (2) California Business and Professions Code section 17 18 6106.3(a) by charging and collecting compensation for services 19 he had not yet fully performed in his clients' residential mortgage loan modification matters. 20

The prior license actions against Respondent as alleged in Paragraphs 2 and 3, above, constitute cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license under California Business and Professions Code section 10177(f). ///

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These proceedings are brought under the provisions of 1 2 Section 10100, Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code 3 of the State of California and California Government Code 4 sections 11500 through 11528.

5 WHEREFORE, the Complainant prays that the above-6 entitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the 7 charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to 8 authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of, a real 9 estate broker license to Respondent, ROMEL AMBARCHYAN, and for 10 such other and further relief as may be proper under other 11 applicable provisions of law.
