The Complainant, Robin Trujillo, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California for cause of Accusation against SUSANA LORENA VIRREY-ZAPIEN, a.k.a. Susana Lorena Virrey ("Respondent") alleges as follows:

1.

The Complainant, Robin Trujillo, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, makes this Accusation in her official capacity.

2.

Respondent is presently licensed and/or has license rights under the Real Estate Law, Part 1 of Division 4 of the California Business and Professions Code as a real estate salesperson.

FIRST CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(CRIMINAL CONVICTION)

On or about June 20, 2012, in the Superior Court of the State of California, Los Angeles County, in Case

No. SA080335, Respondent pled guilty and was convicted for violation of Penal Code Section 529(2) (verifies, publishes, acknowledges, or proves, in the name of another person, any written instrument, with intent that the same may be recorded, delivered, or used as true), a felony. Respondent was sentenced to three years formal probation, two days in jail, and ordered to pay fines, and complete 30 days of community service.

4.

This conviction, by its facts and circumstances, bears a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

5.

The crime of which Respondent was convicted constitutes cause under Sections 490 and 10177(b) of the Code for the suspension or revocation of the license and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law.

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SECOND CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(FAILURE TO REPORT)

Respondent did not report in writing to the Bureau of Real Estate ("Bureau") her plea of guilty to the aforementioned felony (entered June 20, 2012). Respondent's failure to report this conviction constitutes cause for discipline under Business and Professions Code Section 10186.2¹ of the license and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law.

California Business and Professions Code Section
10106 provides, in pertinent part, that in any order issued in
resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the Bureau, the
Commissioner may request the administrative law judge to direct
a licensee found to have committed a violation of this part to

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code 10186.2: (a)(1) A licensee shall report any of the following to the Bureau: (A) The bringing of an indictment or information charging a felony against the licensee. (B) The conviction of the licensee, including any verdict of guilty, or plea of guilty or no contest, of any felony or misdemeanor. (c) Any disciplinary action taken by another licensing entity or authority of this state or of another state or an agency of the federal government. (2) The report required by this subdivision shall be made in writing within 30 days of the date of the bringing of the indictment or the charging of a felony, the conviction, or the disciplinary action. (b) Failure to make a report required by this section shall constitute a cause for discipline.
