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California Business and Professions Code ("Code"), as a real estate salesperson.

FIRST CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(CRIMINAL CONVICTION)

3.

On or about January 18, 2013, in the Superior Court of the State of California, County of Los Angeles, in Case

No. 2WA01069, Respondent pled nolo contendere and was convicted for violation of Penal Code Section 415(1) (disturbing the peace), a misdemeanor. Respondent was sentenced to one month probation. On or about April 12, 2013, Respondent's conviction was dismissed pursuant to Penal Code Section 1203.4.

4.

This conviction, by its facts and circumstances, bears a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

5.

The crime of which Respondent was convicted constitutes cause under Sections 490 and 10177(b) of the Code for the suspension or revocation of the license and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law.

6.

California Business and Professions Code Section 10106 provides, in pertinent part, that in any order issued in resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the Bureau, the

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Commissioner may request the administrative law judge to direct
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    a licensee found to have committed a violation of this part to
    pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of investigation
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    and enforcement of the case.
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WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action against all the licenses and license rights of Respondent, MARK RAYMOND WITTCOFF, under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code) and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other applicable provisions of law.
