On or about May 22, 2006, in the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles, in case no. 6JB01103,

Respondent was convicted of violating California Vehicle Code section 12500(a) (driving without a license), a misdemeanor. This crime is substantially related to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

3.

On or about July 28, 2008, in the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles, in case no. KA083821, Respondent was convicted of violating California Health and Safety Code section 11359 (possession of marijuana for sale), a felony. This crime is substantially related to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

The crimes of which Respondent was convicted as alleged herein constitute cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license under California Business and Professions Code sections 475(a)(2), 480(a), and 10177(b).

## (FAILURE TO REVEAL CONVICTION)

In response to Question 25 of his license application, to wit: "HAVE YOU EVER BEEN CONVICTED OF ANY VIOLATION OF THE LAW? ALL STATE AND FEDERAL MISDEMEANOR AND FELONY CONVICTIONS, AND ALL MILITARY AND FOREIGN CONVICTIONS, MUST BE DISCLOSED.

CONVICTIONS EXPUNGED UNDER PENAL CODE SECTION 1203.4 OR A

SMILIAR STATUTE MUST STILL BE DISCLOSED, "Respondent answered "Yes," but failed to reveal the conviction described in Paragraph 3, above.

6.

Respondent's failure to reveal this conviction in his license application constitutes knowingly making a false statement of material fact required to be revealed in said application, which is grounds for denial of the issuance of a license under California Business and Professions Code sections 475(a)(1), 480(c), and 10177(a).

These proceedings are brought under the provisions of Section 10100, Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California and Sections 11500 through 11528 of the California Government Code.

WHEREFORE, the Complainant prays that the aboveentitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the
charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to
authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of, a real
estate salesperson license to Respondent DANIEL JIMENEZ and for
such other and further relief as may be proper under other
applicable provisions of law.
