A C C U S A T I O N

The Complainant, Maria Suarez, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, for cause of Accusation against ANGEL WAYHANG KOU ("Respondent"), is informed and alleges as follows:

1.

The Complainant, Maria Suarez, a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California, makes this Accusation in her official capacity.

2.

At all times herein mentioned, Respondent was and still is licensed and/or has license rights under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code) as a real estate salesperson. Respondent was first licensed as a salesperson on or about July 27, 2006.

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On or about April 3, 2012, in the Superior Court of California, County of San Bernardino, in Case No. FVA801520, Respondent was convicted of violating Penal Code Section 498(b) (theft of utilities), a felony and crime which is substantially related to the qualifications, functions and duties of a real estate licensee. Respondent was placed on three years formal probation.

4.

Respondent's conviction constitutes cause for the revocation or suspension of Respondent's license and license rights pursuant to Business and Professions Code Sections 490 and/or 10177(b).

6.

Business and Professions Code Section 10106 provides, in pertinent part, that in any order issued in resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the Department, the commissioner may request the administrative law judge to direct a licensee found to have committed a violation of this part to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of the case.

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WHEREFORE, the Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action against all licenses and/or license rights of Respondent, ANGEL WAYHANG KOU, for the cost of investigation and enforcement as permitted by law, and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other provisions of law. and for such other and further relief as may be proper under applicable provisions of law.
