On or about October 2, 2008, in the Superior Court of California, County of Riverside, Case No. RIM516943, Respondent was convicted of violating California Penal Code section 261.5 (sex with a minor not greater than three years older or younger), a misdemeanor. Said crime bears a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate license under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

3.

On or about February 4, 2009, in the Superior Court of California, County of Riverside, Case No. RIF147098, Respondent was convicted of violating California Health and Safety Code section 11377(a) (possession of a controlled substance, to wit: methamphetamine), a misdemeanor, and California Penal Code section 12020(a)(1) (unlawful manufacture and possession of a dangerous weapon, to wit: butterfly knife), a felony. Said crimes bear a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate license under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

4.

On or about April 21, 2009, in the Superior Court of California, County of Riverside, Case No. RIF149718, Respondent was convicted of violating California Health and Safety Code section 11377(a) (possession of a controlled substance, to wit: methamphetamine), a felony, and California Vehicle Code section

2800.1(a) (evading a peace officer), a misdemeanor. Said crimes bear a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate license under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

On or about November 18, 2010, in the Superior Court of California, County of Riverside, Case No. RIF10004517, Respondent was convicted of violating California Penal Code sections 496(a) (receiving stolen property), a felony, and 466 (possession of burglary tools), a misdemeanor, and California Health and Safety Code section 11364 (possession of controlled substance paraphernalia), a misdemeanor. Said crimes bear a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate license under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

The crimes of which Respondent was convicted as alleged in Paragraphs 2 through 5, above, constitute cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license under California Business and Professions Code sections 475(a)(2), 480(a), and 10177(b).

These proceedings are brought under the provisions of Section 10100, Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California and Sections 11500 through 11528 of the California Government Code.
