1.

The Complainant makes this Statement of Issues against Respondent in her official capacity as a Deputy Real Estate Commissioner of the State of California.

2.

On or about November 5, 2012 Respondent made application to the Bureau of Real Estate of the State of California for a real estate salesperson license.

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## CAUSE FOR DENIAL

## (CRIMINAL CONVICTIONS)

3.

On or about March 25, 2004, in the Superior Court of the State of California, in Orange County Case No. 03NF4126, Respondent pled guilty to and was convicted for violation of California Health and Safety Code Section 11378 (possession for sale of a controlled substance), and Health and Safety Code Section 11379 (A) (sale or transportation of a controlled substance), both felonies, and admitted to a prior conviction pursuant to Penal Code Section 667.5(B). On or about May 26, 2004, Respondent was sentenced to two years in state prison (to be served concurrently with Case No. 03-CR-1290), ordered to pay fines, and ordered to register as a convicted drug offender pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 11590.

4.

On or about October 18, 2000, in the United States
District Court for the District of Montana, Great Falls
Division, in Case No. CR-99-65-GF-CCL, Respondent pled guilty to
and was convicted for violation of 21 U.S.C. Section 841(A)(1)
and 21 U.S.C. Section 846 (knowingly and intentionally
conspiring to distribute a controlled substance —
methamphetamine), felonies. Respondent was sentenced to 41
months in federal prison, and upon release from custody,
supervised release for five years. In addition, Respondent was
ordered to complete 240 hours of community service.

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These crimes, by their facts and circumstances, bear a substantial relationship to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

6.

The crimes of which Respondent was convicted constitute cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license under California Business and Professions Code Sections 475(a)(2), 480(a), and 10177(b).

7.

These proceedings are brought under the provisions of Section 10100, Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California and Sections 11500 through 11528 of the California Government Code.

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WHEREFORE, the Complainant prays that the above-entitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of, a real estate salesperson license to Respondent, JOSHUA JAMES SILVA, and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other applicable provisions of law.
