FIRST CAUSE FOR DENIAL

(CRIMINAL CONVICTIONS)

2.

On or about March 14, 2001, Respondent was convicted in the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles, Case No. 1LC00703, for violating California Penal Code Section 484(a)(theft), a misdemeanor. Said crime bears a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations, to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

3.

In aggravation, on or about October 27, 1999, Respondent was convicted in the Municipal Court of Whittier Courthouse District, County of Los Angeles, State of California, Case No. 9WH05387, for violating California Business and Professions Code Section 25662(a) (possession of alcohol: under 21 years of age), a misdemeanor.

4.

In aggravation, on or about May 12, 1999, Respondent was convicted in the Municipal Court of Downey Courthouse Judicial District, County of Los Angeles, State of California, Case No. 9DW02874, for violating California Vehicle Code Section 23152(b)(driving with a blood alcohol of .08 or higher), a misdemeanor.

5.

In aggravation, on or about April 22, 1999, Respondent was convicted in the Municipal Court of Downey Courthouse Judicial District, County of Los Angeles, State of California, Case No. 9DW01338, for violating California Penal Code Section 242 (battery), a misdemeanor.

Richard De Jesus Hernandez Statement of Issues

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The crime of which Respondent was convicted, as alleged in Paragraph 2 above, constitutes cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license under Business and Professions Code Sections 475(a)(2), 480(a) and 10177(b).

SECOND CAUSE FOR DENIAL

(FAILURE TO REVEAL CONVICTIONS)

7.

In response to Question 1 in Part D of the license application, to wit: "HAVE YOU EVER BEEN CONVICTED OF ANY VIOLATION OF LAW? ALL STATE AND FEDERAL MISDEMEANOR AND FELONY CONVICTIONS, AND ALL MILITARY AND FOREIGN CONVICTIONS, MUST BE DISCLOSED. CONVICTIONS EXPUNGED UNDER PENAL CODE SECTION 1203.4 OR A STIMLAR STATUTE MUST STILL BE DISCLOSED", Respondent disclosed that he had "DUI" convictions in 1999 and 2000. However, Respondent failed to reveal the convictions described in Paragraphs 2, 3 and 5 above.

8.

Respondent's failure to disclose the convictions, as set forth in Paragraphs 2, 3 and 5 above, in his license application, constitutes an attempt to procure a real estate license by fraud, misrepresentation, or deceit, or by making a false statement of material fact required to be revealed in said application, which is grounds for denial of the issuance of a license under Business and Professions Code Sections 475(a)(1), 480(c) and 10177(a).

These proceedings are brought under the provisions of Section 10100, Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California and Sections 11500 through 11528 of the California Government Code.
