1 On or about August 8, 2014, Respondent pled guilty and was convicted in the 2 Superior Court of California, County of Orange, Case No. 14HM05145 M A, for violation of 3 California Penal Code Section 273.5(a) (Infliction Of Injury On Present Or Former Spouse, 4 Present Or Former Cohabitant, Present Or Former Fiance/Fiancee, Present Or Former Dating 5 Partner, Or Parent Of Child), a misdemeanor.
