22	Respondent is presently licensed and/or has license rights under the Real Estate
23	Law, Part 1 of Division 4 of the California Business and Professions Code as a real estate
24	broker (license no. 01155119).
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(CRIMINAL CONVICTIONS)

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On or about August 24, 2015, in the United States District Court, Central District of California, case no. 2:12-cr-00829-SVW-3, Respondent was convicted of violating two counts of 18 U.S.C. section 152(3) and 18 U.S.C. section 2 (aiding and abetting in knowingly and fraudulently making a false statement in bankruptcy), both felonies. In part, Respondent was sentenced to five (5) years of probation, ten (10) months of home detention, and pay \$1,500 in restitution to fourteen (14) parties for a total of \$21,000. These crimes are substantially related to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a real estate licensee under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

The crimes of which Respondent was convicted, as described above, constitute cause under California Business and Professions Code sections 490 and 10177(b) for the suspension or revocation of the license and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law.

(COSTS)

5.

California Business and Professions Code section 10106 provides, in pertinent part, that in any order issued in resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the bureau, the Commissioner may request the administrative law judge to direct a licensee found to have committed a violation of this part to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of investigation and enforcement of the case.

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WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this Accusation and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered imposing disciplinary action against all licenses and/or license rights under the Real Estate Law (Part 1 of Division 4 of the California Business and Professions Code) of Respondent JUDE RAYMOND LOPEZ for the cost of investigation and enforcement as permitted by law, and for such other and further relief as may be proper under applicable provisions of law.
