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STATEMENT OF ISSUES AGAINST TROY JOSEPH COLLINS

On or about September 3, 2015, Respondent made application to the Bureau for an individual mortgage loan originator license endorsement (hereinafter "MLO license endorsement"). Respondent also accessed his MLO license endorsement application in the NMLS system on the following dates: September 15, 2015, October 14, 2015, and October 21, 2015, to make revisions.

4.

On or about May 7, 1997, in the Superior Court of California, County of Santa Cruz, Case No. S7-01849, Respondent was convicted of violating Penal Code Sections 484(a) (Theft) and 242 (Battery), both misdemeanors.

5.

In response to Disclosure Questions, Financial Disclosure, Question (H)(1) of the MLO license endorsement application, to wit: "Have you ever been convicted of or pled guilty or nolo contendere ("no contest") in a domestic, foreign, or military court to committing or conspiring to commit a misdemeanor involving: (i) financial services or a financial services related business, (ii) fraud, (iii) false statements or omissions, (iv) theft or wrongful taking of property, (v) bribery, (vi) perjury, (vii) forgery, (viii) counterfeiting, or (ix) extortion?", Respondent responded "No," in his MLO license endorsement application and failed to disclose the conviction described in paragraph 4, above, even in subsequent revisions to the original application.

6.

On September 10, 2013, Respondent made application to the Bureau of Real Estate ("Bureau") of the State of California for a real estate salesperson license. In response to PART D, Question 1 of the license application, to wit: "HAVE YOU EVER BEEN CONVICTED OF ANY VIOLATION OF THE LAW? ALL STATE AND FEDERAL MISDEMEANOR AND FELONY CONVICTIONS, AND ALL MILITARY AND FOREIGN CONVICTIONS, MUST BE DISCLOSED. CONVICTIONS EXPUNGED UNDER PENAL

CODE SECTION 1203.4 OR A SIMILAR STATUTE MUST STILL BE DISCLOSED.", Respondent marked the box denoted "Yes," but failed to disclose the conviction described in paragraph 4, above. 7. The facts alleged in Paragraphs 3, 4, 5, and 6, above, constitute cause for the denial of Respondent's application for a MLO license endorsement under Code Sections 10166.05(c), 10166.051(b), and Regulation 2758.3 in that Respondent has demonstrated a pattern of dishonesty and has failed to demonstrate such financial responsibility, character and general fitness as to command the confidence of the community and to warrant a determination that the mortgage loan originator will operate honestly, fairly, and efficiently within the purposes of Article 2.1 of the Real Estate Law. These proceedings are brought under the provisions of Code Section 10100, and Sections 11500 through 11528 of the California Government Code. /// 

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays that a hearing be conducted on the allegations of this Statement of Issues and that upon proof thereof, a decision be rendered that the Commissioner refuse to authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of, a MLO license endorsement to Respondent TROY JOSEPH COLLINS, and for such other and further relief as may be proper under the provisions of law.
