. 19	All references to the "Code" are to the California Business and Professions
20	Code, all references to the "Real Estate Law" are to Part 1 of Division 4 of the Code, and all
21	references to "Regulations" are to Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations.

23	2. Respondent LING-LAIN GINNY LIN ("LIN") is presently licensed and/or has
24	license rights under the Real Estate Law, as a real estate broker. Respondent LIN was
25	originally licensed as a real estate salesperson on September 27, 1988, and as a real estate
26	broker on May 20, 1997. Respondent's real estate broker license is due to expire on May 19,
27	2017.

2	Respondent FAITH GLOBAL GROUP INC. ("FGGI") is presently licensed and/or has
3	license rights under the Real Estate Law, as a corporate real estate broker. Respondent FGGI
4	was originally licensed as a corporate real estate broker on July 7, 2009. Since that date and
5	continuing to the present, Respondent LIN has been the Designated Officer of Respondent
6	FGGI. Respondent FGGI's real estate license is due to expire on February 23, 2018.
7	4.
8	At all times mentioned, in the city of Walnut, County of Los Angeles,
9	Respondents engaged in the business of, acted in the capacity of, advertised, or assumed to act
10	as real estate brokers within the meaning of Code Section 10131(a), including the solicitation
11	for listings of and the negotiation of the purchase and sale of real property as the agents of
12.	others.
13	FIRST CAUSE OF ACCUSATION
14	(Conversion of Trust Funds – LIN)
15	5.
16	On or about August 23, 2013, Respondents entered into a residential real estate
17	purchase agreement as the real estate brokers representing the seller and the buyer for real
18	property located at 119 S. Michillinda Avenue in Pasadena, California.
19	6.
20	At the conclusion of the transaction, the escrow company issued a refund check
21	in the amount of \$15,000.00 to CBM Systems, Inc., a corporation. Even though Respondent
22	LIN is not an owner or officer of CBM Systems, Inc., Respondent took possession of the check,
23	endorsed it and converted the funds to her own use.
24	7.
25	The conduct of Respondent LIN to take funds belonging to another party is a
26	conversion of such funds and subjects her real estate license and license rights to suspension or
27	revocation pursuant to Code Sections 10177(d), 10177(g), and/or 10177(j).

2	(Dissolution of Corporation – FGGI)
3	8.
4	Prior to June 30, 2016, the corporate status of Respondent FGGI was dissolved
5	with the Secretary of State of the State of California.
6	9.
7	The dissolved status of Respondent FGGI as alleged above, is in
8	violation of Regulation 2742(c), and subjects its real estate license and license rights to
9	suspension or revocation pursuant to Code Section 10177(d) and 10177(f).
. 10	10.
11	California Business and Professions Code Section 10106 provides, in pertinent
12	part, that in any order issued in resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the Bureau, the
. 13	Commissioner may request the administrative law judge to direct a licensee found to have
14	committed a violation of this part to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of
15	investigation and enforcement of the case.
