16	The Complainant, Veronica Kilpatrick, a Supervising Special Investigator of the
17	State of California, for cause of Accusation against DONALD DWIGHT DOWE
18	("Respondent"), is informed and alleges as follows:

20	The Complainant, Veronica Kilpatrick, acting in her official capacity as a
21	Supervising Special Investigator of the State of California, makes this Accusation against
22	DONALD DWIGHT DOWE.

24	Respondent presently has license rights under the Real Estate Law, Part 1 of
25	Division 4 of the California Business and Professions Code ("Code"), as a real estate broker.
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On or about December 5, 2014, Respondent pled guilty and was convicted in the Superior Court of California, County of Riverside, Case No. SWM1409492, for violation of California Penal Code Section 273.5(a) (Infliction Of Injury On Present Or Former Spouse, Present Or Former Cohabitant, Present Or Former Fiance/Fiancee, Present Or Former Dating Partner, Or Parent Of Child), a misdemeanor. Respondent was placed on 36 months of summary probation, and ordered to serve 15 days in custody of the Riverside County Sheriff and pay restitution, fines and fees.

4.

The conviction described in Paragraph 3 bears a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

5.

The crime of which Respondent was convicted, as described in Paragraph 3 above, constitutes cause under Sections 490 and 10177(b) of the Code for the suspension or revocation of the license and license rights of Respondent under the Real Estate Law.

6.

Code Section 10106 provides, in pertinent part, that in any order issued in resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the Bureau of Real Estate, the Commissioner may request the administrative law judge to direct a licensee found to have committed a violation of this part to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of the case.
