## ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR A REAL ESTATE LICENSE

- b. On or about August 5, 2014, Lien, as the Qualifying Individual, filed MU1-2 for Respondent with the BRE for an MLO endorsement.
- c. On or about August 11, 2014, Vu, as the Qualifying Individual, filed MU1-3 for Respondent with the BRE for an MLO endorsement, and in relation thereto, filed a Statement of

Issues on January 18, 2017.

Said Statement of Issues was properly served on Respondent on January 18, 2017.

To date, Respondent has failed to file a Notice of Defense, request a hearing or otherwise establish

that Respondent is entitled to the licenses sought.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, pursuant to the authority granted under Section 11520 of the Government Code of the State of California, that the applications of BOONRATE, for a Mortgage Loan Originator License Endorsement are hereby denied.
