## FIRST CAUSE FOR DENIAL

## (CONDUCT UNDERLYING CRIMINAL CONVICTION)

3.

On or about March 17, 2008, Respondent pled nolo contendere and was convicted in the Superior Court of California, County of Kern, Case No. BM726112A, for violation of California Penal Code Section 487(b)(3) (Grand Theft By A Servant, Agent, Or Employee), a misdemeanor. Respondent was placed on three years of court probation, and ordered to serve 30 days in jail and pay restitution, fines and fees.

4.

The conduct underlying the conviction described in Paragraph 3 bears a substantial relationship under Section 2910, Title 10, Chapter 6, California Code of Regulations to the qualifications, functions or duties of a real estate licensee.

5.

The conduct underlying the conviction described in Paragraph 3 above involves dishonesty, fraud, or deceit, which constitutes cause for denial of Respondent's application for a real estate license under Business and Professions Code Sections 475(a)(3), 480(a)(2), and 10177(j).

## SECOND CAUSE FOR DENIAL

## (FAILURE TO REVEAL CONVICTION ON LICENSE APPLICATION)

6.

In response to Question 28, under the Background Information section of her license application, to wit, "HAVE YOU EVER BEEN CONVICTED (SEE PARAGRAPH ABOVE) OF ANY VIOLATION OF THE LAW AT THE MISDEMEANOR OR FELONY LEVEL? IF YES, COMPLETE ITEM 34 WITH INFORMATION ON EACH CONVICTION", Respondent answered "NO," and failed to disclose the conviction described in Paragraph 3 above.

Respondent's failure to reveal this conviction, as set forth in Paragraph 3 above, in her license application constitutes an attempt to procure a real estate license by fraud, misrepresentation, or deceit, or by making a false statement of material fact required to be revealed in said application, which is grounds for denial of the issuance of a license under California Business and Professions Code Sections 475(a)(1), 480(d), and 10177(a).

8.

These proceedings are brought under the provisions of Section 10100,

Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California and Sections 11500 through 11528 of the California Government Code.

WHEREFORE, the Complainant prays that the above-entitled matter be set for hearing and, upon proof of the charges contained herein, that the Commissioner refuse to authorize the issuance of, and deny the issuance of, a real estate salesperson license to Respondent SANDY EMILY BENITES and for such other and further relief as may be proper under other applicable provisions of law.
