DECISION

This Decision is being issued in accordance with the provisions of section 11520 of the Government Code, on evidence of compliance with section 11505 of the Government Code and pursuant to the Order of Default filed on October 9, 2018, and the Findings of Fact set forth herein, which are based on one or more of the following: (1) Respondent's express admissions; (2) affidavits; and (3) other evidence.

This Decision revokes a real estate license and/or license rights on grounds of a criminal conviction and the failure to timely report that conviction to the Department of Real Estate ("Department").

Pursuant to Government Code section 11521, the Department may order reconsideration of this Decision on petition of any party. The Department's power to order reconsideration of this Decision shall expire 30 days after mailing of this Decision, or on the effective date of this Decision, whichever occurs first. The right to reinstatement of a revoked real estate license or to the reduction of a penalty is controlled by section 11522 of the Government Code. A copy of sections 11521 and 11522 and a copy of the Commissioner's <u>Criteria of Rehabilitation</u> are attached hereto for the information of respondent.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1.

On August 17, 2018, Maria Suarez made the Accusation in her official capacity as a Supervising Special Investigator of the Department. On August 28, 2018, the Accusation, Statement to Respondent, and Notice of Defense were mailed, by certified mail and by regular mail, to Respondent's last known mailing address on file with the Department. On October 9, 2018, no Notice of Defense having been received or filed herein within the time prescribed by section 11506 of the Government Code, Respondent's default was entered herein.

3.

Respondent is presently licensed and/or has license rights under the Real Estate Law, Part 1 of Division 4 of the California Business and Professions Code ("Code") as a real estate broker.

4.

Attached as Exhibit A is a true and correct copy of the Accusation filed on August 28, 2018. The allegations contained in the Accusation are taken as true, and the Accusation is incorporated herein as part of this Decision.

DETERMINATION OF ISSUES

1.

The evidence established that Respondent's conviction is substantially related to the qualifications, functions, and duties of a real estate licensee.

2.

Cause for disciplinary action against Respondent exists pursuant to sections $\underline{490}$, 10177(b) and 10186.2 of the Code.

3.

The standard of proof applied was clear and convincing proof to a reasonable certainty.

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<u>ORDER</u>

All licenses and licensing rights of Respondent LAWRENCE DANIEL RAWITCH under the provisions of Part I of Division 4 of the Business and Professions Code are revoked.
