The Real Estate Commissioner has denied your application for a real estate salesperson license, but has provided for the issuance of a restricted real estate salesperson license to you. We enclose a copy of the Commissioner's Decision.

If you wish to obtain a restricted real estate salesperson license under the employ of the broker indicated on your application, please return the RE 552 signed by your broker as certification that he/she has read the enclosed Decision and will exercise close supervision over your activities as a restricted licensee. On the other hand, *if there has been a change in your prospective employing broker* since the submission of your application (either you are no longer going to be employed by the prospective broker named on your application or you have a new prospective broker) you must at once contact the Department of Real Estate's Licensing Flag Section at (916) 576-8652 to obtain a new license application. The new application must be completed and returned before your restricted license will be issued. If you have changed your mailing address, you must submit the new address in writing to the Licensing Flag Section, 1651 Exposition Blvd., PO Box 137013, Sacramento, CA 95813-7013.

If at the time you submitted your license application you did not have a prospective employing broker, and still do not, you will not have to do anything further; your restricted license will be issued once the Decision has been processed by our Licensing Section.
