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ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE

On August 15, 2019, in Case No. H-41248 LA, a Decision was rendered revoking the real estate broker license of Cortney Arthur Ensign and the corporate real estate broker license of Mesa Management Inc., effective September 9, 2019, but granting Respondents the right to issuance of a restricted real estate broker license and a restricted corporate real estate broker license. Restricted real estate licenses were issued to Respondents on September 9, 2019, and Respondents have held restricted licenses since that time.

On April 3, 2023, Respondents petitioned for reinstatement of Respondents' real estate broker and corporate real estate broker licenses, and the Attorney General of the State of California has been given notice of the filing of the petition.

I have considered Respondents' petition and the evidence submitted in support

1 thereof. Respondents have demonstrated to my satisfaction that Respondents meet the
2 requirements of law for the issuance to Respondents of unrestricted real estate broker and
3 corporate real estate broker licenses and that it would not be against the public interest to issue
4 said licenses to Respondents.

5 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondents' petition for
6 reinstatement is granted and that real estate broker and real estate corporation licenses be issued
7 to Respondents if Respondents satisfy the following requirements:

8 1. Submit a completed application and pay the fee for a real estate broker
9 license and a real estate corporation license within the 12 month period following the date of this
10 Order; and

11 2. Submit proof that Respondent Cortney Arthur Ensign has completed the
12 continuing education requirements for renewal of the license sought. The continuing education
13 courses must be completed either (i) within the 12 month period preceding the filing of the
14 completed application, or (ii) within the 12 month period following the date of this Order.

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16 This Order shall become effective immediately.
