3	Respondent JOAN A KINDT ("KINDT") presently has license rights under the

15	acts and omissions in the First Amended Accusation as grounds for disciplinary action.

20	Respondent KINDT acted as a real estate broker, conducting licensed activities within the
21	meaning of Code section 10131(b) (leases or rents real property for others).
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FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION

FAILURE TO RETAIN RECORDS

7.

Respondent KINDT acted in violation of the Code and the Regulations in that a subpoena was served to KINDT for the production of books and records related to the property management activities conducted by KINDT. KINDT failed to retain and make available for examination, copying, and inspection the books, accounts, and records related to KINDT'S property management activities, in violation of Code section 10148, which constitutes cause under Code sections 10177(d) and/or 10177(g) for the suspension or revocation of all the licenses and license rights of KINDT.

8.

Code section 10106 provides, in pertinent part, that in any order issued in resolution of a disciplinary proceeding before the Department of Real Estate, the Commissioner may request the administrative law judge to direct a licensee found to have committed a violation of this part to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of the case.
