ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE

On June 1, 2020, in Case No. H-41623 LA, a Decision was rendered revoking the real estate salesperson license and the Mortgage Loan Originator (MLO) license endorsement of Respondent effective July 24, 2020, but granting Respondent the right to the issuance of a restricted real estate salesperson license and a restricted MLO license endorsement. A restricted real estate salesperson license was issued to Respondent on September 18, 2020 and a restricted MLO endorsement was issued to Respondent on September 24, 2020.

On August 6, 2021, Respondent petitioned for reinstatement of Respondent's real estate salesperson license and MLO license endorsement, and the Attorney General of the State of California has been given notice of the filing of the petition.

I have considered Respondent's petition and the evidence submitted in support thereof. Respondent has demonstrated to my satisfaction that Respondent meets the requirements of law for the issuance to Respondent of an unrestricted real estate salesperson license and an

1 unrestricted MLO license endorsement and that it would not be against the public interest to
2 issue said licenses to Respondent.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's petition for
4 reinstatement is granted and that a real estate salesperson license and a MLO license
5 endorsement be issued to Respondent if Respondent satisfies the following requirements:

6 1. Submits completed applications and pays the fee for a real estate
7 salesperson license and a MLO license endorsement within the 12 month period following the
8 date of this Order; and

9 2. Submits proof that Respondent has completed the continuing education
10 requirements for renewal of the licenses sought. The continuing education courses must be
11 completed either (i) within the 12 month period preceding the filing of the completed
12 applications, or (ii) within the 12 month period following the date of this Order.

13 This Order shall become effective immediately.
